Protecting wine grape growers from bushfire smoke taint

When vineyards and grapes are exposed to smoke, this can result in wines with undesirable sensory characteristics such as smoky, burnt, ashy or medicinal flavours.



Wine grape growers can protect themselves from financial loss if their grapes take on smoke taint caused by a nearby bushfire.

How does it work?

Smoke taint from bushfire poses a significant threat to wine industry worldwide, but its impact on the Australian varieties has been particularly pronounced. The devastating losses experienced during the 2019 bushfire events have highlighted the need for specialised insurance solutions. In response, we have developed a solution that enables Australian vineyard owners and winemakers to help protect their investments from smoke taint damage.

Instead of relying on subjective claims processes, our approach is based on objective scientific research1 and laboratory testing. We specifically focus on the four main volatile phenols that have been proven to have a significant effect on the "smokiness" of the flavour on the sensory assessment:

These compounds have been shown to be key indicators of smoke exposure and wine taint levels in grapes. This provides a robust basis for determining coverage and the loss payable under the policy will be determined by the combined amount of these compounds found in the grapes from testing conducted by Affinity Labs (the commercial testing arm of AWRI) and also the type of grape which has been smoke tainted.

We have a streamlined claims process so once a sample of the grapes has been collected, sent for testing and we have the test results, it is a simple process to determine coverage with no further involvement from a loss adjuster required.
